HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT UPDATE

Current cost of blacktop is \$61/ton – up from \$51/ton last year. Highway Superintendent Pete Darabon expects the price to keep going up throughout the summer.

365 ft of culverts have been fixed so far.

COURT CLERKS

Recommendation of the court clerk hiring committee to hire Carol Tuttle for the 29 hr/wk court clerk position and Michelle Oehler for the 15 hr/wk court clerk position was approved with a motion by Councilwoman Gang and Deputy Supervisor Bump. All in Favor – Carried.
